The Buckeye Ranch is a private, non-profit provider that has been serving children and families in Ohio for over 60 years.

Opening in 1961 as a treatment center for 10 young men, it has now transitioned into a leading provider of emotional, behavioral and mental health services for children and families in Ohio. Each day, more than 2,350 youth are in The Buckeye Ranch's care, receiving services designed to help them become successful within their families, schools and communities.

With 6 locations and over 500 dedicated staff, a number of successful mental health services and programs across our four service lines - Child Welfare, Community and Education-Based services, Residential, and Integrated Care - are operated for youth and families across the state.

# What is the Somali Outreach Program?

The Somali Outreach Program provides culturally-competent and specific intensive and non-intensive clinical and case management services. Through the use of Somali-speaking case managers, we provide support for Somali youth and families struggling with symptoms related to loss, trauma and resettlement, as well as issues that are common to the process of merging cultures. The outreach component of the program connects Somali families to community resources specific to their needs and provides acculturation services to the Somali community and in Franklin County.



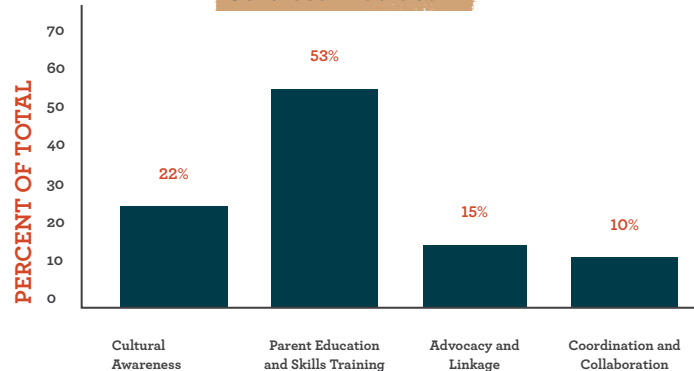
# What Services are Offered?

The Somali Outreach Program emphasizes collaboration with other systems and service providers to support families in communities.

Outreach activities includes:

- Somali culture training workshops
- Community prevention workshops
  - Multi-agency collaboration and coordination
- Individual acculturation sessions
  - In-school group sessions
  - Youth prevention workshops
  - Navigation and service linkage
  - School acculturation on-site consultation
- The Buckeye Ranch staff Somali culture trainings
- Culturally appropriate parenting classes
  - Consumer advocacy

- Families challenged with grief, trauma, and resettlement issues
- Children experiencing mental or behavioral health problems at home or school
- Families experiencing acculturation challenges
  - Parent education or assistance
  - Children abusing alcohol or drugs
