



The Buckeye Ranch: My Place

Within our Child Welfare service line, The Buckeye Ranch provides Transitional Age Youth services to help support youth who are aging out of the foster care system.

My Place is a unique program within Transitional Age Youth services, offering transitional housing and support for males and females ages 16 to 21 years old. My Place is a program, not just a placement, with a goal to provide young adults transitioning out of foster care a stable place to learn advanced life skills and grow into the adults they are meant to be in their communities.



RESIDENTIAL OFFERINGS AND SUPPORT



- Located at 1625 E. Mound St., Columbus, OH 43205
- Includes 15 fully furnished, one-bedroom apartments
- Secured apartment building with 24/7 on-site staff support
- Skill-building classes for residents hosted by the My Place team, including financial literacy, nutrition, cooking, house skills, education advancement, and more
- Amenities, including a laundry facility, fitness room, outdoor basketball court, and a community room complete with a TV, video game system, and computer
- Outside perimeter of building monitored by surveillance cameras to ensure a safe and secure environment for residents
- Ability for placement of adults with children to be placed together
- Direct access to other Buckeye Ranch programs and support services
